The Hunger Prevention Partnership of Portage County is offering a limited number of grants (\$6000 available) to fund activities that prevent or reduce hunger.

Grants are available as a result of our annual Empty Bowls Events. These funds are used to develop and sustain programs that both prevent hunger and increase food security.

Prevention: For activities that help prevent hunger, such as:

- ✓ Increasing awareness of local hunger issues such as: community campaigns, media, or other projects
- ✓ Educating children about hunger
- ✓ Collaboratively addressing hunger
- ✓ Expand current efforts to increase the impact on hunger

Supplemental Food Assistance: To assist organizations in meeting food assistance needs in Portage County.

The Hunger Prevention Partnership must receive all grant applications no later than September 15, 2016. Incomplete or late proposals will not be considered.

Approval of the grants will be done October 5th, 2016. Initial funds will be dispersed at Empty Bowls on October 22nd, 2016.
